# For Community Care Nurses

The Basic Dermatology Nursing Course for community care nurses seeks to empower nurses with essential knowledge and skills, as well as to provide safe and competent care to the residents.

#### **01** Objectives

- Acquire knowledge and skills of dermatological nursing care
- Demonstrate competency in managing residents with mild to moderate common skin conditions

#### 02 Core Content

- Understand the basic structure and functions of the skin
- Identify the difference between normal and abnormal skin changes
- Perform basic skin assessment and understand the use of common dermatology terminology
- Demonstrate techniques of topical application, wet wrap therapy and scabies management

## **03** Training Methods

- Four education training modules
- On-site competencies assessment tests
- Undertake basic skin assessments to understand the use of common dermatology terminology
- Lectures, videos, demonstration of practicum and case discussions
